Paris - Lucerne - Florence - Rome - Venice - Innsbruck - Heidelberg - Amsterdam - London, 14 nights

Day 1 - Paris

Paris – the City of Lights - is the starting point of your tour. Meet your coach and transfer to the city centre, where you will be met by your local guide. Your introduction of this amazing metropolis begins with a half day guided city tour taking you to the landmarks of Paris including Champs Elysees, the Arc de Triomphe and the Eiffel Tower. Dinner and overnight in Paris.

Day 2 - Paris – Disneyland – Paris

Visit Disneyland Paris today where you'll meet all your favourite Disney characters and enjoy fun filled rides. Early evening transfer back to Paris to experience the breath taking views of Paris by night with a cruise on the River Seine. Dinner and overnight in Paris.

Day 3 - Paris – Lucerne

This morning you leave Paris and head for Lucerne, Switzerland. Relax on the coach and take in the scenery along the way. Dinner and overnight in Lucerne.

Day 4 - Lucerne – Mt Titlis – Lucerne

Drive to Engelberg today and take the Titlis Rotair cable car to the top of Mount Titlis (3238m). Experience the stunning sights of the snow capped Alpine peaks from the summit. Return to Lucerne and tour this beautiful medieval town. You'll see the famous 14th century Chapel Bridge, the Lion Monument and the Jesuit church. Spend the balance of the day strolling through quaint Lucerne. Dinner and overnight Lucerne.

Day 5 - Lucerne – Jungfrauoch – Lucerne

Experience the beauty of the Swiss Alps by taking the cogwheel train to the highest mountain railway station in Europe, Jungfrauoch. Visit the amazing Ice Palace and the beautiful ice sculptures. Return to Interlaken, the pretty town nestling at the foot of Jungfrau. Spend some time on your own before having dinner in Interlaken. Overnight in Lucerne.

Day 6 - Lucerne – Florence

Leave the magic of Switzerland and its breath taking scenery and head towards Italy - one of the most historical and majestic countries of Europe. Dinner and overnight in Florence.

Day 7 - Florence – Pisa – Rome

Join a half day walking tour of Florence. See the famous sights such as the Duomo, Piazza della Signoria and of course Ponte Vecchio. After some time at leisure you leave Florence and head to Rome - the eternal city. En route you stop to marvel at the magnificent Leaning Tower of Pisa. Dinner and overnight in Rome.

Day 8 - Rome

Today unravel this historical metropolis with your local guide who will guide you to Colosseum, the Pantheon, and the Trevi Fountain. Walk along the Piazza Navona and join the locals at the Spanish steps. Continue your discovery of Rome with a visit to the Vatican. Dinner and overnight.

Day 9 - Rome – Venice

This morning you leave Rome and head to one of the most enchanting cities in the world – Venice. Dinner and overnight in Mestre.

Day 10 - Venice – Innsbruck

Today you take the Vaporetto water taxi to Venice Island where you will meet your local guide for a half day tour. See St Mark's Square, Doges Palace and the Bridge of Sighs. Your sightseeing will end at a glass blowing factory. Depart in the afternoon and travel to Innsbruck Stop en route to visit world famous Swarovsky Crystal Factory. Dinner and overnight in Innsbruck.

Day 11 - Innsbruck – Heidelberg

Your short orientation tour of Innsbruck will include the famous Maria Teresia Square, after which you leave Austria and drive through Bavaria to Heidelberg, Germany's oldest university city. A short orientation tour includes the famous Castle ruins. Dinner and overnight in Heidelberg.

Day 12 - Heidelberg – Amsterdam

Drive through the picturesque Rhine Valley and cruise on the river Rhine, passing by fairytale castles perched on leafy hilltops. Continue to Cologne where you have a short stop to visit the majestic cathedral. Proceed to Amsterdam for dinner and overnight.

Day 13 - Amsterdam – Brussels – London

Take a city tour of Amsterdam including a canal cruise. See the Royal Palace and the beautiful 17th century houses from the "Golden Age". Continue to visit the world famous Keukenhof tulip gardens and then to Brussels where you board the Eurostar. Arrive in London a few hours later. Dinner and overnight in London.

Day 14 - London

Take a guided tour of this truly cosmopolitan city. Major sights include Buckingham Palace, Houses of Parliament, Westminster Abbey and the Tower of London. Afternoon is free to shop along Oxford Street, Bond Street or at Harrods in Knightsbridge. Don't miss the London Eye, from where you will have breathtaking views of London. Dinner and overnight in London.
